NOTICE

Subject: Renewal Admission into UG 3rd & 5th Semester (Session: 2026-27)

This is to inform all students seeking renewal admission into the UG 3rd and 5th Semester classes for the Academic Session 2026-27 that the admission process is tentatively scheduled to commence by the end of July 2026, subject to the forthcoming notifications and fee waiver guidelines from the Government of Assam. All students are advised to keep their necessary documents updated and readily available for submission at the time of admission.

Furthermore, students intending to avail of the Fee Waiver Scheme must ensure that all required certificates and supporting documents are strictly valid and up to date as per the enclosed government guidelines. Please note that students carrying backlogs in their previous examinations are not eligible to avail of the fee waiver scheme. The detailed admission schedule will be notified separately in due course. Students are requested to regularly check the College website and the Notice Board for further updates.

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Guidelines For availing Fee Waiver Scheme

1. Students whose parents, either father or mother, are not employees of the State Government, Central Government, Semi-Government organisations, State Government undertakings or Central Government undertakings. However, provided that, where either or both parent of the student is employed as Grade-IV/MTS post under the State Government, Central Government, Semi Government organisation. State Government undertaking or Central Government undertaking, the student may be considered eligible for the Fee Waiver Scheme, subject to fulfillment of all other prescribed eligibility conditions.
2. The student must be a permanent resident of Assam and must possess domicile of Assam in order to avail benefit under the Fee Waiver Scheme. The concerned Higher Educational Institution shall verify the residential/domicile status of the student through valid supporting documents as may be prescribed or notified by the Government.
3.
 - i. **Students who have arrears/backlogs in the previous academic year shall not be eligible to avail the Fee Waiver Scheme.**
 - ii. **Students who have not enrolled for the final examinations of the previous academic year shall also not be eligible to avail of the Fee Waiver Scheme.**
4. Fee waiver will be revoked if any beneficiary student indulges in vandalism, ragging, misconduct, and anti-social activities, which may affect the academic atmosphere of the HEIs.
5. Ration Card issued by the competent authority shall be treated as the primary proof of income. The Ration Card must be issued by the competent authority of the State of Assam. Ration Cards issued by any other State shall not be accepted for claiming benefit under the Fee Waiver Scheme.
6. If the Ration Card is not available, only then will an income certificate issued by the concerned Revenue Circle Officer shall be accepted
7. A declaration shall be obtained from the student stating that neither parent, father or mother, is an employee of the State Government, Central Government, Semi-Government organisation, State Government undertaking or Central Government undertaking. Such declaration form shall be devised by the concerned Registrar/Principal. If such declaration is found to be false, the admission under the Fee Waiver Scheme shall be cancelled and the admission fee shall be realised from the student.
